

Terms of Horse Sale - - Please Read Carefully.

1. All horses Must be Presented and Recommended in an honest way.
2. The sale committee reserves the right to check any horse for age before or after entering sale ring to verify correct presentation.
3. Mares in foal sell as “Exposed” unless they have been vet checked.
4. The sale committee reserves the right to announce any unsoundness or problem observed.
5. All prospective buyers are urged to carefully inspect the animal they are interested in before buying and to pay careful attention to all announcements made as the animal enters the sale ring.
6. If the buyer thinks the horse has been misrepresented they can bring it to the sale committee’s attention before removing the animal from sale grounds. If the animal has been misrepresented it can be resold **AT THE SALE COMMITTEE’S DISCRETION**. After the horse is removed from auction grounds, all guarantees are between buyer and seller.
7. When consignors consign their horse to be sold, or prospective buyers register for a buyer number, they are agreeing to these terms of sale, whether they have read them or not.

Terms of sale:

- Commission rates: On horses \$15 consignment fee + 8% on the first \$3,000 then 5% on remaining balance. All other items 15% up to \$500 - 10% on items over \$500. No sale Fee: \$50 on horses and \$30 all other items.
- Due to the good selection of catalogued horses, we are asking you to reconsider before bringing any uncatalogued horses. Uncatalogued horses will sell late in the day.
- All out of state horses need health papers brought with them. All horses need current coggins test. Vet on site to provide coggins test at sellers expense. Only health horses will be run through the sale ring.
- Small animal and poultry consignors must provide cage or box.
- Goats and sheep must have scrapie tags.
- Out of state cattle must have TB Test & out of state fowl need health papers.
- Tax will be charged on some items. (Horses, Equipment & Small Animals are exempt.) Bring your dealer tax number or tax exemption form.
- Cash, check, or credit card accepted with proper ID.
- Owner and Auction company not responsible for accidents, theft, or loss of sale items.
